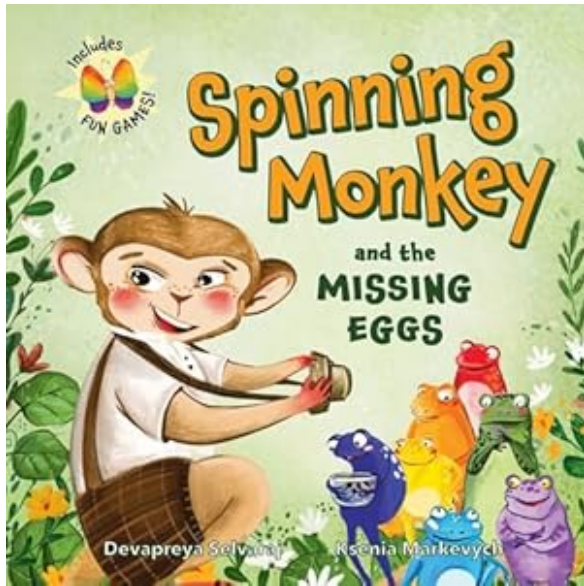

But when a storm washes away most of their eggs, their peaceful world is turned upside down. But soon after they manage to get their eggs back, a thief begins stealing them one by one! Each night, a different animal friend stands guard, with the aid of clever tools from Spinning Monkey's treasure box. But the thief continues to outsmart them. At last, Spinning Monkey uses his trusty camera to capture snapshots that reveal the culprit. But will they be able to stop the culprit before their last egg is taken?

What makes Devapreya Selvaraj's story worth reading is that it is adventurous and engaging. The storytelling encourages young readers through problem-solving and teamwork.
